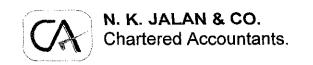

(A) <u>SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES</u>:

(1) Basis of Accounting:

Financial Statements are prepared on cash basis, except for audit fees, no other provisions are made.

(2) Debenture Redemption Reserve:
